

The list below encompasses some common AP exams that UCI Nursing Science students take and how they might impact your course planning. <b>Biology</b>	3, 4, or 5	8	Nursing Science majors earn one Biological Sciences course toward Category II of the UCI GE requirement
<b>Calculus – AB</b>	3	4	Elective credit only
<b>Calculus – AB</b>	4 or 5	4	MATH 2A or MATH 5A (satisfies Category Vb of the UCI GE requirement)
<b>Calculus – BC</b>	3	8	MATH 2A or MATH 5A (satisfies Category Vb of the UCI GE requirement)
<b>Calculus – BC</b>	4 or 5	8	MATH 2A-MATH 2B or MATH 5A-MATH 5B (satisfies Category Vb of the UCI GE requirement)
<b>Chemistry</b>	3	8	Elective credit only
<b>Chemistry</b>	4 or 5	8	CHEM 1A, plus an additional 4 units of elective credit
<b>English – Language and/or Literature</b>	3	8	Elective credit and satisfies the Entry Level Writing Requirement
<b>English – Language and/or Literature</b>	4 or 5	8	One course toward Category I of the UCI GE requirement for WRITING 39B, one course toward Category IV of the UCI GE requirement for ENGLISH 10 or ENGLISH 12, plus 4 units of elective credit
<b>Languages other than English</b>	3	4 - 8	Some languages will only grant elective credit ONLY Some languages will satisfy Category VI of the UCI GE requirement
<b>Languages other than English</b>	4 or 5	4 - 8	Specific courses will vary depending on the language, but all will satisfy Category VI and VII of the UCI GE requirement
<b>Psychology</b>	3	4	Elective credit only
<b>Psychology</b>	4 or 5	4	PSCI 9 or PSYCH 7A (satisfies Nursing Science Psychology Lower Division Major Requirement)
<b>Statistics</b>	3, 4, or 5	4	STATS 7 or STATS 8 or MGMT 7 or SOCECOL 13 or EDUC 15 (satisfies Nursing Science Statistics Lower Division Major Requirement)

Note: Credit will be granted for AP scores of 3 and above; at times this may come in the form of elective credit that counts towards the minimum 180 units needed to graduate. Refer to the UCI General Catalogue for additional information.
