I. Writing	3	<ul> <li>Students must satisfy the UC Entry Level Writing Requirement (ELWR) before starting their lower-division writing courses.</li> <li>Students will take two lower-division writing courses. <ul> <li>It is advised that students complete these courses as soon as possible, ideally before the start of the second year.</li> <li>Students may waive the first lower-division course (39B) with certain AP scores. They should consult with an academic advisor to confirm.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Students will take their upper-division writing course(s) in their required coursework during their third and fourth year</li> </ul>
II. Science and Technology	3	<ul> <li>The following required Nursing Science coursework will count towards this requirement:         <ul> <li>Chemistry 1A</li> <li>Chemistry 1B</li> <li>Chemistry 1C</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
III. Social & Behavioral Sciences	3	<ul> <li>The following required Nursing Science coursework will count towards this requirement:         <ul> <li>Nursing Science Sociology/Anthropology Requirement</li> <li>Anthropology 2A OR 2D OR 41A OR Sociology 1 OR 2 OR 3 OR 31 OR 62</li> <li>Nursing Science Psychology Requirement</li> <li>Psychology 7A OR 9A OR 9B OR 9C OR 78A OR Psychological Science 9 OR 11A OR 11B OR 11C</li> <li>Public Health 1</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
IV. Arts & Humanities	3	<ul> <li>The following required Nursing Science coursework will count towards this requirement:</li> <li>Nursing Science Philosophy Requirement (Philosophy 4 or 5)</li> </ul>

V. Quantitative, Symbolic, and Computational Reasoning	3	<ul> <li>Students are required to take <u>one</u> course in <u>each</u> of the subcategories (Va and Vb) and an additional course from either subcategory, for a <u>total of three</u> courses.</li> <li>The following required Nursing Science Coursework will count towards the Va component of this requirement:         <ul> <li>Chemistry 1A</li> <li>Chemistry 1B</li> <li>Chemistry 1C</li> <li>Nursing Science Statistics Requirement</li> <li>Statistics 7 OR 8 OR Psychology 10A OR Sociology 10A OR Social Sciences 10A</li> </ul> </li> <li>None of the required Nursing Science coursework will count towards the Vb component of this requirement; however, it is possible to have AP/IB Score credit applied to this part of the Category V requirement.</li> </ul>
VI. Language Other Than English	1	<ul> <li>None of the required Nursing Science coursework will count towards this requirement; however, it is possible to apply the following to the Category VI requirement:         <ul> <li>Community College coursework</li> <li>Test score credit (APP, SAT Subject Test, UCI Placement Test)</li> <li>3 years of high-school coursework in a language other than English</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
VII. Multicultural Studies	1	<ul> <li>The following required Nursing Science coursework will count towards this requirement:         <ul> <li>Some courses in the Nursing Science Sociology/Anthropology</li> <li>Requirement: Sociology 1 OR 3</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
VIII. International/ Global Issues	1	<ul> <li>The following required Nursing Science coursework will count towards this requirement:         <ul> <li>Some courses in the Nursing Science Sociology/Anthropology Requirement: Anthropology 2A OR 41A OR Sociology 2</li> </ul> </li> <li>It is also possible to apply the following to the Category VIII requirement:         <ul> <li>Test score credit (APP, SAT Subject Test, UCI Placement Test)</li> <li>4 years of high-school coursework in a language other than English</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

## **Common Strategies and Considerations for Nursing Science Majors**

- o The General Chemistry Series (1A-1B-1C) will "double-up" and count towards Categories II and Va
- o Sociology 1 or 3 will count towards Categories III AND VII
- o Anthropology 2A, Anthropology 41A, or Sociology 2 will count towards Categories III AND VIII
