

## MEPN Application – Prerequisite Checklist Instructions

Applicants are required to fill out a “Prerequisite Checklist” (located on the School of Nursing MEPN Admissions website at <https://nursing.uci.edu/admissions/mepn-admissions/>) and upload it in their application. Applicants may only use this form; any other versions of this form (e.g. lists of courses in a Word document) will not be accepted.

This is a sample of how the checklist should be filled out:

**NOTE:** Some schools combine the lecture and lab components of Microbiology, Human Physiology, and/or Human Anatomy. If this is the case for your prerequisite(s), please fill out course information in the “lecture” row and write “see above” in the “lab” row. As a reminder, we do not require a lab for the Chemistry requirement.

All of the following prerequisites must be completed with a letter grade of C or higher by December 31st preceding the program start date. Checklists will courses planned for the following Winter/Spring term will not be accepted.
